No ID? You can apply for free voter ID

The UK Government has introduced a requirement for voters to show photo ID when voting at a polling station. This means that voters in Hart will now be required to show photographic identification at polling stations before they are given a ballot paper. This will affect all voters across Hart who vote in person or by proxy at the next local election due to be held on Thursday 4 May 2023.

Which forms of ID can I use to vote?

You may already have a form of photo ID that is acceptable. You can use any of the following:

- Passport
- Driving licence (including provisional license)
- Blue badge
- Certain concessionary travel cards
- Identity card with PASS mark (Proof of Age Standards Scheme)
- Biometric Immigration document
- Defence identity card
- Certain national identity cards

Expired photographic identification will also be accepted if the photograph is of a good enough likeness to allow polling station staff to confirm the identity of the holder. For more information on which forms of photo ID will be accepted, visit <u>electoralcommission.org.uk/voterID</u> or call their helpline on 0800 328 0280.

If you don't have an accepted form photo ID

If you don't already have an accepted form of photo ID, or you're not sure whether your photo ID still looks like you, you can apply for a free voter ID document, known as a Voter Authority Certificate...

When applying for a Voter Authority Certificate, you will need to provide your:

- Name
- Address
- Date of birth
- National Insurance number found on payslips or official letters about tax, pensions or benefits
- A recent photograph

You should apply using the same name that you used to register to vote.

You can still apply if you don't know your National Insurance number, or don't have one. You will need to provide other forms of proof of identity, such as a birth certificate, bank statement and a utility bill.

Postal and Proxy Vote

Postal voters will not be affected and will be issued with their postal ballot papers as usual. If you choose to vote by proxy, then the person who you have trusted to vote on your behalf will have to take their own identification in order to be issued with a ballot paper.

SUPPORTING RESIDENTS

Fleet Link Bus Service

For those that may not know, the Fleet Link Bus is a bookable bus service for people living in the parishes of Fleet and Church Crookham that may have difficulty using or do not have access to a regular bus service.

The service runs at certain times through the week with options to travel to the high street, Morrisons and on certain days, trips to The Meadows/Camberley & Farnborough Kingsmead/Town Centre.



Ancells Farm Green Gym



As you may recall from our last Town Talk in July 2022, the Council approved an S106 application being made to Hart District Council to fund a new Green Gym in Ancells Farm Park.

For information S106 is money contributed by developers to the local planning authority (Hart), towards the costs of providing community and social infrastructure to mitigate the impact of their development on the local community/infrastructure. The Gym would, pending approval, be funded by this developer money and not from Council Tax.

For good measure and public reassurance, a survey of local residents was conducted online during August - September to confirm that the Gym was still wanted and to see what equipment was desired and location preferences within the park.

At Decembers RLA meeting Members considered the equipment, location and revised cost. It was approved that the following equipment be installed: 1. Stepper, 2. Disabled Arm & Pedal Bike, 3. Upper Body Machine, 4. Skier and 5. Rower, located by the footpath, across from the under 8's play area.

Equipment will be ordered and installed once the \$106 funding has been agreed by Hart District Council.

Fleet Town Council 2023/24 Budget & Precept

Fleet Town Council maintains a range of facilities and services for residents, including The Harlington, playgrounds and award winning public open spaces, supporting the High Street, and the cemetery.

The 2023/24 budget has been planned in a difficult financial climate; post COVID and in a period of high inflation. Consequently, the Council agreed at their meeting on 4th January 2023, that the precept will be increased for the coming year. This increase represents an extra **19 pence per week** (Band D) for the continuation of services and enables the Council to plan for the future. **What we will spend for Fleet town next year...**
