As you may know, the Council were locked in a battle with Thames Water, who after months of frustration and denying responsibility, found a hole in their foul water sewer which has since been repaired. Thames Water have also conducted some repairs to the footpath caused by the sinkhole.

Fleet Town Council and The Harlington's new websites are live! More user friendly and accessible than before, we hope residents' can easily navigate them to find the information they need. The Council also invested in new systems such as Hallmaster, an online booking system - you can now book rooms at The Harlington, Ancells Farm Community Centre and hire the parks via an online bookings calendar.

In early March, we reached an important milestone with the signing of a long-term lease with Hart District Council for The Harlington. This agreement marked a significant step forward in securing the venue's future and provided the foundation to begin planning essential renovation work.

The lease enabled us to look ahead with confidence, ensuring The Harlington could continue to serve as a centre for community-focused activities and a varied programme of entertainment, while also enhancing the experience of all who use it

We remain grateful to everyone who supported us throughout this journey. Their encouragement made this achievement possible and signalled the beginning of an important new chapter for The Harlington and the community it serves.



Celebrating Dedication

Councillor Sue Tilley's passion and commitment to both Fleet Town Council and the wider community have been recognised with the highest honour from the Lions — the Melvin Jones Fellowship, presented by Lion President Mike.

THE VIEWS SKATEPARK RENOVATION

The much-loved Skatepark at The Views, already planned for renovation, was closed and decommissioned following a safety inspection, marking the start of an exciting new chapter.

Earlier this year, consultations with young residents took place, with a big thank you to Fleet Phoenix for their collaboration and support. The tender process then followed, and the panel – including Fleet Phoenix, user representatives, Fleet Town Council Clerk, and councillors – met to review the bids. Contractor Fearless Ramps has been selected and we are waiting for the Public Works Loan Board to approve the loan before commencing work.

Alongside these activities, The Harlington also houses key local services. Fleet Town Council's offices are based here, giving residents direct access to council staff in the town centre. Within The Point, youth charities Fleet Phoenix and Sasha's Project provide vital support: Fleet Phoenix runs youth clubs, mentoring and creative projects for young people, while Sasha's Project offers a late-night crisis centre for those facing mental health struggles.

As The Harlington undergoes renovation, plans are being developed for a temporary location to host a reduced programme of its existing offer. This will help ensure that community groups, services and facilities can continue to run during the transition, keeping the spirit of The Harlington alive until the new space is ready.

WHAT'S NEXT

Thank you to all residents and users of The Harlington who have contributed to this important project so far. Following public and user engagement, our architects developed three design options for the renovation.

In October, these options were shared for public voting. By the end of November, the results will be in and the final design will have been selected — an exciting milestone for the project!

WHY AND WHEN?

While plans have not yet been finalised, the current estimated timeline sets the new and improved Harlington for completion in early 2028.

It will include improved access, upgraded toilets and bar facilities, and comfier seating; including a balcony to increase ticket sales and draw in bigger acts.

New mechanical and electrical infrastructure will be installed, including a eco friendly air source heat pump, double glazing, insulation and solar panels, to help reduce emissions and lower bills.



THE HARLINGTON RENOVATION – AT A GLANCE

Q: Why now?

A: The building is ageing with leaks, poor insulation and outdated systems. Renovation will keep it safe, usable and energy-efficient for years to come.

Q: What's the benefit?

A: Modern, comfortable facilities, lower energy use and costs, better events and audience experience, and a smaller carbon footprint.

Q: Who's responsible?

A: Fleet Town Council manages and maintains The Harlington under a long-term lease from Hart District Council.

Q: How have residents been involved?

A: Resident feedback is guiding the project. Voting slips were posted in October to all households, with regular updates shared on our website, social media and noticeboards.


